CEdMA certification exam pricing effective January 1, 2020:

- The CEdMA Certified Technical Training Manager exam is \$295
- Any vouchers expire after 12 months

Online Proctored Exam Troubleshooting Tips

- 1. **Internet speeds.** Testers must have a minimum of 1mbps upload and download with a ping of 200ms or less. If testers have internet speeds worse there will be issues launching the exam.
- 2. **Contact the Kryterion support team** at any point if there are any issues launching or taking your online proctored exam. This includes enrollment and launching issues.

3. Make sure enrollment and authentication photos are taken in a clear well-lit environment. The testers face should be clearly visible and looking into the camera.

<u>I booked the online proctored exam delivery and I meant to book the onsite proctored delivery . Can I change it?</u>

You will need to cancel the exam at least 72 hours before it is scheduled and then book the onsite exam.

Is there any extra guidance for taking an online proctored exam?

You will need an external web camera to take the test remotely. Get your system set up 72 hours before the test time.

Your test time is based on your location in your Kryterion profile. Please make sure that your location is correct in your Kryterion test profile.

Find a quiet place where no one else will enter the room. The exam will be stopped if others are seen in the room. The test will also be stopped if you leave the room or go out of the view of the camera. The remote proctor may also interrupt the exam if they see other actions taking place outside normal test-taking activities.

Which question types are on the test?

The exams are made up of multiple choice questions and include both single answer and multiple answer questions. In the case of a multiple answer question, the number of answers required will be indicated in the question.

Is there a non-disclosure agreement associated with the exam?

Yes, before attempting an exam, you must agree to the terms of the non-disclosure agreement (NDA).

What identification is required onsite at the testing center?

Two forms of identification are required at the Testing Center, which the proctor verifies and records. The Kryterion Certified Proctor (KCP) will provide you with documentation about preparing for your test session while your workstation is prepared in the testing room. My exam is showing the wrong time zone so I am not sure when to attend. What should I do?

Go into your Kryterion account and make sure the *Country* and *Province* are correctly selected. Make the necessary changes and the time zone will automatically change to reflect your selected location.

Will the exams be available to take remotely? What is needed to take an exam remotely? Do I need an external camera?

Yes. The exam can be taken remotely as online-proctored exams.

60% or higher * 60 questions * This is subject to change

How long does each test take to complete?

Each exam is 90 minutes*. * This is subject to change

• Plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled exam time to check in, review the NDA, and be seated and ready to start your exam at your scheduled exam time.

Do I get a hardcopy certification certificate in the mail? Do I get a digital badge?

We do not mail hard copy certificates. You will be sent digital badge information to the email address in your Kryterion CEdMA account.

How long do you have to wait before retaking an exam?

These times are subject to change and you can retake an exam up to a maximum of 5 times.

How long is my certification valid?
