How do I get certified?

1. Prepare
 - Read the book “[Technical Training Management](#)” and/or
 - Follow the [Technical Training Manager Program](#) online self-study.
2. [Register for an on-line proctored exam](#):
 - **You must cancel at least 24 hours in advance of an on-line proctored exams to avoid any cancellation fees.**
3. Go take the Exam
 - If you sign up for online proctored testing, give yourself 48 hours to properly set up your equipment. An external web camera is required.
4. After
 - Get your digital badge directly from Credly/Acclaim
 - Add your certification badge and credential to your CV/Resume, LinkedIn and your email signature
